On September 5, 2016, John C. (Jack) Downey, age 66, of Wexford, beloved husband of Kathy King Downey; loving father of Megan Downey (Robert) Ambrogio & John Max-Patrick Downey; grandfather of Gavin John Ambrogio; son of John J. (Lisa) Downey & Mary Glaser (Raymond) Roposh; sister of Mary Graff, Denise (Frank) Carothers & Sarah (Richard) Manning; also survived by many nieces and nephews.

Jack was a teacher for Northgate School District for 39 years. He dedicated 44 years coaching student athletes in track-n-field, football, basketball & wrestling. Jack held the position of Head High School Track-n-Field coach for 27 years initially for Northgate and then Avonworth - Northgate Co-op. Jack graduated from Avalon High School in 1968, Westminster College in 1972 and earned his Masters from the University of Pittsburgh. Jack played football on the Westminster College National Championship NAIA Division II Football team in 1970. He was an avid fisherman, sportsman, enjoyed babysitting his grandson 3 days a week, walking North Park, playing cards and served as an Usher at Christ Episcopal Church.

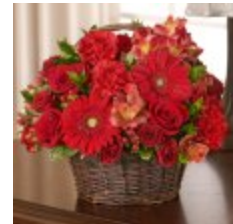

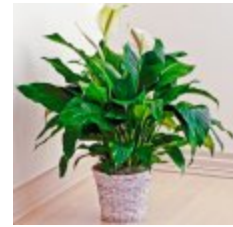
