



## John R. Rumisek

June 3, 1920 - February 25, 2015

John R. Rumisek, 94, of McCandless Township, died naturally and peacefully on Wednesday, February 25, 2015, attended by his children at Passavant Hospital. He was the loving husband of the late Olga Marie Rumisek, who died in 1965, and the late Helen Price Foster Rumisek, who died in 2006; beloved father of John D. (Joan Ratliff) Rumisek M.D., Ellen M. John was born June 3, 1920 to immigrant Czech parents, John and Anna Rumisek, and was raised in West Mayfield, PA; attended Geneva College where he met his future wife Olga, who was a Spanish teacher at the college; served his country in WWII as a Captain in the 8th Air Force, 486th Bombardment Group as Chief of air control operations in Sudbury, England; settled his family in McCandless; was an active businessman with Koppers Company in Pittsburgh and later a member of the Greater Pittsburgh Chamber of Commerce senior staff; and was a member of the Masonic Lodge
