The reason for the anonymity of the post is that it will forever represent the collective memory of all of the children who look up to our uncle as the role model he is.

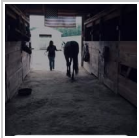

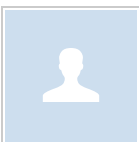
