On Tuesday, September 24, 2013, Susan B. Stewart, age 71, died at her residence in The Township of McCandless with family and loved ones at her side. The daughter of Harry C. Bantly, MD and Regina Hitchins, she was born in 1942 while her father was serving as a battalion surgeon in the U.S. Army Medical Corps during World War II. Spending her childhood on a small farm, Mrs. Stewart developed her life-long compassion for animals, dogs, cats, and horses in particular. A graduate of The Grier School and Marjorie Webster Junior College, she devoted her adult life to her family while finding time to teach sewing and tailoring. As an artist, she expressed her creativity through oil painting, rug hooking, weaving and other fiber arts. Mrs. Stewart is survived by her husband of 50 years, Leonard L. Stewart and her children: Jack (Sharon) Stewart of Seven Fields, Andrew B. Stewart (Kristine Bryan) of Tipp City, OH, and Stephanie Messer of McCandless; her brothers David (Pamela) Bantly of Punxsutawney and Douglas (Penny) Bantly of Reynoldsville. She was the loving grandmother of nine grandchildren, all of whom she adored: Scott, Daniel, and Matthew Stewart, Alyssa, Ian and Lydia Stewart, and Annie, Stewart, and Reed Messer.
