Lewisburg State Penitentiary and Western Penitentiary and ran a halfway house in the North Side. He owned The Kitchen in Sewickley and afterwards became an insurance agent. His final career, where he still worked, was as a financial advisor at American Equity Services which he started with his son in 1991.

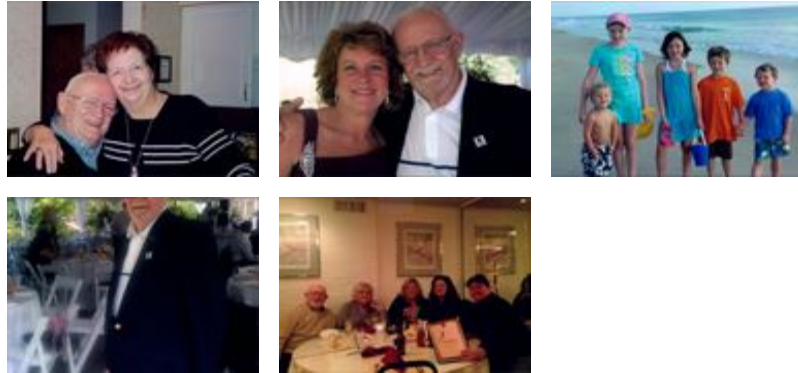
