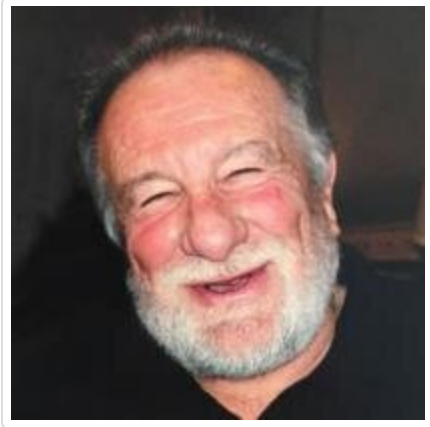




Mr. Wm. Paul Harrington, Jr.
